

Entrance Test for classes 1 to 6 SYLLABUS

As the exam starts at 9:00 a.m. you are requested to be present in the school at 8:45 a.m. punctually, no extra time is given to the child to complete the test.

Both Parents are requested to accompany the child for the test. No other relative will be allowed to sit for the duration of the test inside the school campus. Parents are requested to switch off their mobile phones while inside the campus, in case of emergency you may step out of the school gate to talk on your phones.

Kindly keep in mind the weather of Nainital and dress your daughter very warmly.

Children will carry their pencil boxes and exam board for the test.

Parents are required to wait inside the school at the designated place for the three hour period of the test. Kindly come prepared for the same. The result will be declared within a week's time on the school's website.

Refreshments are provided in the school but you may carry your own snacks and drinks for the children as well.

Important points to keep in mind regarding your daughter's admission form submitted in our school before going in to see the Principal for an interview on the same day.

- The spelling of name of the parents and child should be the same on the admission form, birth certificate, adhaar card and report card of the child photocopies of which are attached with the form
- The date of birth should be the same on the admission form, birth certificate, adhaar card and previous school documents.
- No column should be left blank in the admission form if something is not applicable kindly cross out. The Guardian column is compulsory to fill, kindly ensure it is not crossed out or left blank.
- If there are many corrections in the form it will be rejected and you will be required to purchase and fill a new form to submit in our office.
